MARLBOROUGH, MA - Mayor Arthur Vigeant and Labor Day Parade Director Melanie Whapham are thrilled to announce Marlborough's annual Labor Day Parade will continue this year marking 71 years of tradition.

This year's parade will feature a route change. The parade starts at the intersection of Pleasant and Lincoln Streets, proceeds west onto Lincoln Street, south onto Broad Street and east onto West Main Street. The parade will continue down Granger Boulevard and briefly turns onto Main Street. The parade will turn south onto Maple Street, ending at the intersection of Bolton Street (Route 85) and Maple Street. Due to ongoing construction, the parade will not go down Main Street.
